







## THE OPEN LETTER

#### The INVESTMENT LOCATIONS AND PROJECTS of Branicevo and Danubian Districts

The "The Investment locations and projects" in Braničevo and Danubian District, has been drawn up with the aim of creating the ambience opened for any type of investment, with the primary goal of attracting direct investments which will bring new technologies, new programs as well as sales of the products in other markets.

The Regional Chamber of Commerce of Požarevac, amidst its numerous activities directed towards creating conditions for improving economic development, has drawn up this publication, with the objective of presenting the actual status and development potentials of the area covered by the RCC of Požarevac.

There are two conceptual units in the Publication. The first part outlines the most prominent features of all the eleven municipalities situated in the area of Braničevo and Danubian District, while the second part presents the programs defined by their promoters.

The Region's economy comprises about 2.500 registered actively operating enterprises of various ownership forms. Out of the total number, private enterprises account for 88%. According to the field of operation, most enterprises deal with trade (57%), followed by industry (20%), agriculture (8%) and civil engineering (7%).

As regards coal and electricity production, Kostolac Surface Open-pit Coal Grounds and Thermal Power Plant stand out in the Region,. With their coal production, these enterprises represent the top capacities not only in the Region, but also in whole Serbia. The public company of Kostolac Thermal Plants is the third important power producing capacity in the Serbian electric power system.

Agriculture is another very important potential of the Region, with 347.173 ha of high quality agricultural land.

This area produces annually 150.000 t of wheat, 510.000 t of corn, 34.000 t of sugar beat, 8.000 t of sunflower, 9.500 t of apples, 7.500 t of plums and about 42.000 t of grapes. On the basis of such rich base, adequate processing capacities have been built.

There is an outstanding development potential in the Danubian belt which includes a portion of the European inland water traffic network of about 35.000 km, with the Danube itself in its centre, with 2.850 km of traffic route through the Region.

The second portion of the Publication presents projects defined by their promoters as regards the subject of investing, value, available resources, level of realization and the purpose of cooperation. This unit has been designed so as to accommodate modifications and to be open for all new investments. The projects are classified according to areas of investment, with the intention of offering the basic information on the proposed projects to potential investors.

The Publication is intended as an invitation for cooperation to possible investors and also to all promoters of ideas and programs in the Region who are looking for partners.

As "All the glory ensues from the courage to commence", RCC of Požarevac wishes to launch an initiative and show that there is a lot to be offered by this Region, looking forward to developing and improving business communication among those who are able to recognize the opportunity.

#### The INVESTMENT LOCATIONS AND PROJECTS of Branicevo and Danubian Districts




The territory covered by the RPK of Požarevac covers Braničevo and Danubian District, on the area of which there are 11 municipalities. The total are of the territory is 5.113 km², which accounts for 5.7% of the total area of the Republic of Serbia. There are 410.793 inhabitants in the Districts living in 247 settlements, and they account for 5.4% of the total population of the Republic of Serbia.

The Region is situated in the north-east part of Serbia covering the portions of the lower flow of the River Velika Morava and its confluence with the Danube, complete area of the River Mlava watershed and most of the River Pek watershed. In the north, the Danube is the northern border of the Region, with Homolje and Kučaje Mountains in the south-east, while in the west there are the slopes of Šumadia mountains and hills.

The geographical situation of this area, its openness and good traffic connections with other parts of Serbia by roads, railway lines and rivers, as well as the direct leaning on Belgrade area, offer significant advantages for its economic development. The largest portion in the industrial output of the Region is covered by waterworks, coal production, ferrous metallurgy, metal processing, machine building, food production, textile, leather, footwear production and other industrial branches. In the area of the Region, agricultural production is exercised at the area of 347.173 ha out of which 245.653 ha are the arable land and vegetable gardens. There are 2.348 active enterprises in the Region. They employ more than 89.000 workers.

# **BRANIČEVO DISTRICT**

The INVESTMENT LOCATIONS AND PROJECTS of Branicevo and Danubian Districts

Braničevo District is situated in the nort-east part of Serbia and includes eight municipalities: Golubac, Kučevo, Malo Crniće, Veliko Gradište, Žabari and Žagubica. The total population is 200.503.

According to its geographical situation, the District is very suitable for economic development. There are important traffic routes across the area. It is rich with mineral resources, primarily high quality coal. Agriculture is developed mostly in the area of Stig and in the river valleys of the Danube, Velika Morava, Mlava and Pek. Energy production in the basin of TE Kostolac is of significance not only for the District but for the whole Republic of Serbia. In addition, there are also resources of coal, petroleum and water. The Region's economic structure mosaic is completed of metal, textile and food industries, as well as the developed traffic. There are also favorable natural conditions for production of building materials, especially brickwork. High quality sand and gravel are extracted from the riverbeds of the Danube and Velika Morava, while lime is produced in the area of Kučevo municipality, thanks to the rich and high quality natural resources. Owing to the rich nature of the whole area, i.e. its rivers, forests, hills and mounds, as well as to the cultural and historical monuments and other facilities, there are possibilities for developing of specialized modes of tourism, especially those related to hunting and fishing.

# GOLUBAC

#### Situation

Golubac municipality covers the area of 368 km2, leaning on the Danube in the length of 52 km along the frontier with Romania.

In the town of Golubac and the 24 settlements of the municipality, there are 9.913 inhabitants.


#### Infrastructure


Golubac is connected with Veliko Gradište, Požarevac and Kladovo by the Djerdap motorway. It is also reliant on the navigable Danube route.

#### **Economy**

Agriculture is the main economic branch. About 40% of the population is involved in agriculture. Crops growing is most widely spread /wheat, corn and sunflower/, as well as intensive vegetable production. The existing processing facilities are insufficient so that the production is oriented towards the regional processing plants.

There are 52 registered enterprises and 230 shops in the municipality. According to structure, the enterprises mostly deal with trade (58 %), processing industries (15 %) and agriculture (15 %).





#### **Natural Resources and Potentials**

The 13.824 ha of agricultural land comprises arable land of 7.740 ha, with 691 ha of orchards and 276 ha of vineyards, while 515 ha are covered in meadows and pastures.

There are significant forest resources, stone and lime reserves.

Other potentials for economic development, especially those related to tourism:

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# Municipality of KUČEVO

#### Situation

The municipality of Kučevo covers the area of 721 km2 in the central portion of the District and the area of the lower course of the River Pek, one of the few auriferous European rivers.

In the town of Kučevo and its 23 villages, there are 18.808 inhabitants.

#### Infrastructure

Kučevo is linked with other parts of the country by the motorway Beograd


- Požarevac Majdanpek Zaječar, and by railway line Beograd Požarevac
- Majdanpek Prahovo (the port on the Danube).


#### **Economy**

Natural resources (forests, stone and lime reserves) have directed the economic structure in the municipality of Kučevo.

The agricultural production, as the most significant economic branch, comprises land cultivation as the base for the developed sheep and cattle growing activities. There follow wood processing, production of lime and stone, and also the tourist industry.

There are 50 registered economic entities and 404 shops in the municipality. The enterprise structure comprises trade (54 %) as the most numerous activity, followed by industry (22 %) and agriculture and forestry (10 %).





#### **Natural Resources and Potentials**

In the structure of the entire municipality, agricultural land covers 35.547 ha, i.e. one-half, with the other half covered by forests. Arable land covers 17.062 ha with crops grown there, while orchards are planted at 2.490 ha, vineyards at 355 ha, with meadows and pastures cover the area of 15.640 ha.

The mountain portion of the municipality is rich with deposits of stone, quartz, high quality coal and metal ores. Research works are in progress regarding discovering deposits sufficient for mining of gold and capturing mineral water springs in Neresnica and Šumeće Wells.

Other potentials for development of economy, with the focus on tourism are:

- Kučevo tourist settlement. It is equipped with rather satisfactory infrastructure, services and superstructure facilities, a hotel (120 hotel beds), a sports hall, football pitches and other accompanying facilities.
- The cultural and historical monuments: Kraku lu Jordan the ancient Roman foundry, Kučajka the remains of an ancient Roman mine,
- Tourist complexes: Homolje Caves with Gaura Mare the large cave as a speleological monument of the nature,
- · Homolje Motifs tourist event

# MALO CRNIĆE

#### Situation

The municipality of Malo Crniće is situated not far from Požarevac. It stretches along the valley of the River Mlava, covering the area of 273 km2. The population of Malo Crniće and its 19 villages is 13.853.

#### Infrastructure

Malo Crniće is incorporated into the regional road route of Požarevac - Petrovac - Žagubica - Bor.


#### **Economy**

Agriculture is the most important branch of the economy, where growing crops and cattle are the major activities.

Industrial capacities comprise those of food processing (production of flour and pastry).

In the field of economic activities there are 43 registered enterprises and 271 shops. As regards the structure of the enterprises, trade constitutes major portion (70 %), followed by agriculture and forestry (18%), and processing industry (5 %).





#### **Natural Resources and Potentials**

The high quality arable land is the most important natural resource. In the structure of the agricultural land of 20.871 ha, arable land covers 14.362 ha, orchards 668 ha, vineyards 501 ha and meadows and pastures are of 1.170 ha area.

Malo Crniće has no tourist infrastructure that would enable valorization of the possibilities and potentials that, among other things, include cultural-historical monuments and forest assets rich with water and game. Hotel capacities (10 motel beds and 21 beds in local homes), football and sports terrains are insufficient but necessary as the base for further development.

Other potentials for tourist industry development are as follows:

- Cultural and historical monuments and remains from the ancient Roman times, "Bradača" Monastery, "Zaova" Monastery - The Church dating from the 14th century, "Municupium" (the Roman military fortification), and "Fedras" Festival,
- Complex tourist facilities: "Zaova", "Jezero" Motel, Hunters' Home, as well as the forest area of 120 ha (know as a rich game reservation).

# **POŽAREVAC**

#### Situation

The municipality of Požarevac is situated in the area covering the junction of the Rivers Velika Morava and Mlava and the Danube, covering the area of 491 km2.

In the towns of Požarevac, Kostolac and the municipalitiy's 27 villages, there are 74.902 inhabitants.

#### Infrastructure

Pošarevac is linked with other parts of the country by the Beograd - Niš highway, and the motorway which links it with Smederevo, Kučevo, Veliko Gradište, as well as by way of the railway line Beograd - Bor - Zaječar.

The municipality is also dependant on the navigable route of the Danube and a portion of the Velika Morava navigable route.

In Kostolac, there is a sports airport and a heliodrom.

The natural gas lines also cross this territory.

The available telecommunication systems comply with all contemporary requirements and the need for transmission of communications.

#### Economy


Požarevac has a relatively well developed economic structure.


The economic facilities are dominated by the power production /the basin of Kostolac/ and by agriculture with food processing industry leaning on the agricultural output.

Metal and chemical industries are also present, as well as textile industry and furniture and footwear production.

There is a special place in the economy for production of coal and electric power.

The economy includes 448 registered enterprises and 1.966 shops. As regards the enterprises' structure according to activities, trade leads the way (65%), followed by processing industry (17%), civil engineering (6%), agriculture and forestry (5%)





#### **Natural Resources and Potentials**

The main resource is the high quality agricultural land at the area of 31.197 ha, out of which arable land covers 25.269 ha, orchards 1.247 ha, vineyards 935 ha and meadows and pastures 3.743 ha.

- Tourist facilities: Ljubičevo Tourist-Recreational Centre, Ethno-Park in Tulba, "Prugovo" Park of nature, Kostolački Dunavac – the tourist-nautical centre, the Rivers Danube, Velika Morava and Mlava, are the sites suitable for the tourist industry development.
- The cultural-historical monuments: "Margum" the ancient Roman fortification, "Viminacium" the ancient Roman town-fortress in Kostolac, monasteries and churches dating from the medieval Battle of Kosovo, "Milena Pavlović Barili" Fine Arts Gallery, Ljubičevo Horse-Racing Games
- Hotel capacities: (367 beds in hotels and motels and beds in private homes), sports halls, gyms, football stadium and sports fields.

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# VELIKO GRADIŠTE

#### Situation

The municipality of Veliko Gradište lies at the confluence of the Rivers Pek and Danube, covering the area of 344 km2.

In the town of Veliko Gradište and the municipality's 26 villages, there are 20.659 inhabitants.

#### Infrastructure

Veliko Gradište is connected by motorway with Požarevac - Veliko Gradište - Golubac - Kladovo.

It leans on the Danube navigation route and the port.


#### **Economy**

Veliko Gradište municipality is predominantly agricultural area, with developed crops and vegetable growing outputs, also including production of industrial crops.

Tourist industry accounts for a significant contribution to the overall economy.

Within the economy, there are 121 registered enterprises and 985 shops. According to the enterprises' activities, mostly present are trade (47 %), processing industries (32 %), and agriculture with forestry (12 %).





#### Natural resources and potentials

Agricultural land covers 24.152 ha, out of which 19.320 ha are covered by arable land, 960 ha by orchards, 900 ha by vineyards, and 2.970 ha by meadows and pastures.

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#### Site

The municipality of Žabari is situated at the centre of the lower River Morava course, along the right-hand side of the River Velika Morava, covering the area of 263 km2.

In the town of Žabari and the municipality's 15 villages, there live 13.034 inhabitants.

#### Infrastructure


Žabari is connected with Beograd – Niš highway and Požarevac – Svilajnac regional motorway.

#### **Economy**

The municipality's economic structure is characterized by developed agriculture. Crops growing /wheat and corn/ prevails on the plough-land, followed by vegetable growing which has got a long tradition and growing of industrial plants /sunflower, sugar beat, soy/.

The economy also comprises 33 registered enterprises and 236 shops. The enterprises' structure according to type of activities is as follows: trade (48%), agriculture (18%) and processing industry (18%).





#### **Natural Resources and Potentials**

The municipality-s agricultural land is the most important natural resource. In the available agricultural land of 21.043 ha, the plough-land covers 17.452 ha, while 1.625 ha are under orchards, 1.076 ha are covered with vineyards and 889 ha with meadows and pastures.

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# Municipality of **ŽAGUBICA**

#### Situation

The municipality of Žagubica covers the area of Mt. Homolje of the 760 km2area. According to size, it is one of the largest in Serbia.

In the town of Žagubica and the municipality's 18 villages, there live 14.832 inhabitants.


#### Infrastructure


Žagubica is linked with the regional Požarevac - Petrovac - Bor – Zaječar motorway.

#### **Economy**

The economic structure of the municipality reflects its natural resources. Cattle growing is a dominant branch in the overall agricultural output. Among the most important economic activities in the municipality, there are the wood-processing capacities (joinery hardware) and extraction of brown coal and of volcanic-origin minerals.

The economy incorporates 60 registered enterprises and 203 shops. According to activities, the enterprises' structure comprises trade (33 %), processing industry (25 %) and agriculture (26 %).





#### **Natural Resources and Potentials**

There is the agricultural land of 39.471 ha, out of which there is 9.868 ha of arable land, 2.763 ha of orchards and 26.840 ha of meadows and pastures. Forests cover the area of 36.421 ha.

#### **Natural Resources**

- Mineral resources: brown coal, rare minerals of volcanic origin, stone, metal ores
- Water springs: the Mlava Springs, the Belosavac Springs, Krupajsko Well and thermal springs.
- · The hunting area covers 68.286 ha.
- There is a huge discrepancy between the potentials and the current level of infrastructure development (insufficient accommodation capacities of just 64 motel beds) and of the accompanying facilities

There are great potentials for the development of tourism in the territory of Žagubica municipality:

- Tourist complexes: Bosutova the strict reservation of nature and the Osanička River Gorge, Samar the geo-morphological natural monument, the Mlava Springs, Krupajsko Well, the Belosavac Springs, Homolje sinking waters as the hydrological natural monument, thermal springs,
- Cultural and historical monuments: the remains from the ancient Roman times, Gornjak Monastery, Trška Church (under the state protection program),
- · Events: "Homolje Sprigns"

# PETROVAC NA MLAVI

#### Situation

The municipality of Petrovac upon Mlava is situated in the central portion of the River Mlava watershed, covering the area of 655 km2.

In the town of Petrovac and in the municipality's 34 villages, there live 34.511 inhabitants.

#### Infrastructure


Petrovac is connected with Požarevac – Bor regional motorway, through Žagubica.


#### **Economy**

In the economic structure of the municipality, there prevail the capacities for processing of the available raw material resources, agricultural products, wood, resources of minerals and coal.

Agriculture, with the prevailing crop-farming and cattle-growing activities, is the most important branch of the economy.

In the economic field, there are 185 registered enterprises and 802 shops. The enterprises' structure consists of trade (64 %), processing industry (16 %) and agriculture with forestry (9%).





#### **Natural Resources and Potentials**

Petrovac municipality covers the land which is most suitable for the development of cattle growing, crops farming and of vegetable gardening. In the agricultural land structure of 49.000 ha, arable land covers 35.770 ha, orchards 392 ha, vineyards 980 ha, and meadows and pastures 8.330 ha.



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## DANUBIAN DISTRICT

The INVESTMENT LOCATIONS AND PROJECTS of Branicevo and Danubian Districts

The Danubian District stretches along the southern brim of the Pannonian basin and along the northeast upland of Šumadija. The District incorporates three municipalities: Velika Plana, Smederevo and Smederevska Palanka. The population is 210.290.

The District's territory is intersected by Budimpešta-Beograd-Niš-The-ssalonica-Athens highway which connects the District with other motorways with eastern Serbia and central Šumadija, and farther on with western Serbia. According to its geographical situation, as well as in relation to its water, agricultural, energy and forest resources, the District has got excellent development potentials. The Danube itself is a special asset for this area, as it enables connections with central Europe and the Black Sea. In addition to the cultural inheritance of these three municipalities, the superb potentials for tourism development contribute to the attractiveness of this tourist destination.

# **SMEDEREVO**

#### Situation

The municipality of Smederevo covers the area immediately in front of the junction of the Rivers Velika Morava and Danube, of the 481,5 km2 area. The Danube's length of 20 km and 27 km of the Velika Morava regulated water course constitute the northern and eastern borders of the municipality. In the town of Smederevo and the municipality's 25 villages, there live 109,809 inhabitants.

#### Infrastructure

Smederevo is linked with Beograd-Niš highway, with connections to Vojvodina by a regional motorway (the bridge over the Danube). Railway traffic is one of the best developed in Serbia, incorporating the E-85 Beograd - Niš line as the section of the trans-continental railway main route with the railway inter-station in the town of Mala Krsna.

The Port of Smederevo (as the part of the Beograd-Smederevo-Pančevo-Kovin system of ports), accommodates both river and sea vessels of up to 8.000 tons capacity. Goods can be transported from Smederevo Port to 65 other major ports, while the extensive town's hinterland has got the population of 450 million consumers.

There is a sports airport in Smederevo.


Smederevo is connected to the natural gas network.

The telecommunication systems meet all the modern transmission requirements.

#### **Economy**

As regards economy, the municipality of Smederevo belongs to the most significant areas in Serbia, when considering its available economic potentials. The economic structure of the municipality of Smederevo is of a classical character, with the dominant participation of industry, agriculture and trade. There are 604 registered enterprises and 3.230 shops in the municipality. According to their structure, the majority deal with trade (63 %), followed by processing industry (18 %), civil engineering (8%), traffic and connections (6%), agriculture (3%).





#### **Natural Resources and Potentials**

There are 39.105 ha of agricultural land in the municipality of Smederevo, out of which 32.066 ha are covered with arable land, 2.737 ha with orchards, 2.346 ha with vineyards and 1.955 ha with meadows and pastures.

#### Natural potentials:

Among the potentials and resources which enable further economic development, and especially the development of tourism, there are:

- Cultural-historical monuments of Kulič the ancient Roman fortification, Smederevo fortress, events such as Smederevo Autumn, Nušić's Days, Golden Fishermen's Pot, "Grafika" – the fine arts colony,




